The oldest concrete cricket pitch in ACT was surveyed by Peter Wightman and John Balfour and laid at a working bee in 1921. CEW Bean, the war historians and local players formed a team named the 'Tuggeranong Twisters' and played their first match on 1 April 1921.

Cricket provided a social outlet for recreation throughout the Tuggeranong and Queanbeyan districts. Teams from Michelago, Burra, Williamsdale and Queanbeyan came to play at the homestead.
